ARC Repeater Aids MVARC's Cub Scout Event

The Mount Vernon Amateur Radio Club (MVARC) provided an amateur radio demonstration for Cub Scouts in Troop 888 on Saturday, May 2 at the Coast Guard Station, Alexandria

Immediately prior to the event, MVARC's 2-meter repeater developed an issue with its power supply, which caused weak signal and an intermittent audio hum. The MVARC lead for the event and Club Vice-President made a request to the Alexandria Radio Club for use of our repeater to support the event from 1300-1500 on Saturday. The request was supported and the amateur radio demonstration was the hit of the day for the Cub Scout troop of approximately 75 scouts, with many actually getting on the radio with other hams both locally and



nationally. The scouts enjoyed over two hours of managed voice contacts and learned some amateur radio basics on a gorgeous spring day.

As this scout event was part of a weekend overnight activity, there were also many parents in attendance who, after observing the demonstration of both HF and VHF/UHF radios, besieged the presenters with questions about how to get licensed, what type of equipment should they get and how much will it cost them to get on the air. Maybe we'll have some future members coming out of that group.

Supporting MVARC for this event continues to demonstrate the long-standing relationship between the two clubs. ARC uses the MVARC repeater to support parades and other public service events in Old Town Alexandria.


Six Earn New Tech Licenses at ARC Test Session

- 1. For the April 11th meeting of the Alexandria Amateur Radio Club, 29 people were in attendance with 21 people in-person and 8 people participating in the online zoom meeting.
- 2. **Sean Gallagher, K4KBK**, summarized the topics discussed at the March 2025 board meeting, which included changing the club financial institution to the local Burke and Herbert bank with many branch locations and longer duration office hours than employee-based credit unions.
- 3. **Richard Morani, KW4UJ**, discussed the treasurer's report with a total account balance of near \$13,817 with an upcoming payment of a cellular data bill for almost \$47.
- 4. **Sean Gallagher, K4KBK**, mentioned that approximately eleven members now have expired memberships without current membership dues payment. Club membership retention lead, **Bob Crumley, KO4ZIK**, will make contact with all delinquent members.

- 5. **Jan Maas, KB2LRX**, discussed the City of Alexandria commemoration of the D-Day invasion with the French city of Caen, along with public release activities for Field Day.
- 6. **Sean Gallagher, K4KBK**, introduced a new emergency communications committee chair, **Stefano Fonda, K4IEW**.
- 7. **Richard Morani, KW4UJ**, discussed the education and testing report with the statement that the next testing session scheduled for May 6th. In addition, approximately fifty percent of the people who originally start any class finish the curriculum and pass the exam.
- 8. **Sean Gallagher, K4KBK**, discussed that current club trailer project is the replacement of cabinets and shelves as designed by **Joe Porcelli, KT3I**. Sean had previously completed replacement of the trailer's existing 12-year-old batteries and conducted a spring cleaning and reorganization in preparation for the 2025 parade season.
- 9. **Richard Morani, KW4UJ**, will insert a new link for club hats and shirts on the website as soon as it is available from **Louis Mingo, KO4QVB**, lead for club clothing items. The link will direct the member to an external site which will allow ordering and payment for club hats and shirts.
- 10.**Bryan Pettigrew, WD4ADF**, will soon be holding a new net controller class with date and time TBD. A special net will be held at 19:30 on 4/15/2025 on the club 1.25 meter repeater.
- 11.**Sandy Kenyon, KQ4DNE**, and **Bob Crumley, KO4ZIK**, discussed club preparations for Field Day 2025. A field day coordinator and additional volunteers are still being recruited. The reservation for the city park has been confirmed. **William Wilson, KM4KLK**, is revising the menu and is taking suggestions.
- 12.**Sean Gallagher, K4KBK**, mentioned that the activities calendar is now on the website.
- 13.**Sean Gallagher, K4KBK**, discussed that D-Star and DMR operations are now on the top of the Elmer workshop topics requests.

- 14.**Ian Keith, N8IK**, stated that since the DMR repeater was using a Yagi instead of a vertical antenna, the operating area was restricted and not allowing many local area club members to use the repeater.
- 15.**Sean Gallagher, K4KBK**, mentioned that the Virginia QSO Party results will be released after April 15th.
- 16.**Sandy Kenyon, KQ4DNE**, has accepted the position of club membership recruiting coordinator.
